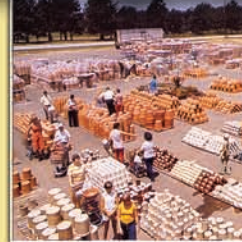

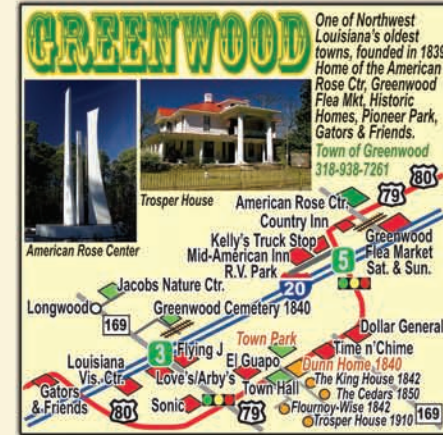
House of Good Things
